





Review the "Gold-to-Silver Rule" on Page 2 before playing!

Players: 2-4

Playing Tokens: None

Objective: Ride the Trail! Form the longest connection of Betski[™] Cards.

How to Play:

- **1)** Thoroughly shuffle the Betski[™] deck.
- 2) The match begins with <u>each player</u> flipping over a single card in the center of the table. This will be referred to as the "Center Card".
- 3) Each player then has to build off of their Center Card by taking turns flipping additional cards from the Betski[™] deck, connecting them using the **Gold-to-Silver Rule**. Refer to Page 2 for additional instructions on how to make proper Gold-to-Silver Rule card placements.
 - a) Players must decide upon a turn rotation order.
 - **b)** Each player connects their own "Trail" of cards by setting a valid Gold-to-Silver placement card to the right of the previously placed Center Card.



- 4) Once the turn order has been established and each player has received a Center Card, the first player must draw from the Betski™ deck and see if the card can be connected to their "Trail". They must play the card as soon as they draw it.
 - **a)** If the player is **able** to connect the card to their Trail, they must put the card to the right of their most recently placed Center Card. It is now the next player's turn.
 - **b)** If the player is **unable** to connect the card to their Trail, it must be discarded. It is now the next player's turn.
- 5) The match ends when all the cards in the deck have been flipped, and whoever has created the longest "Trail" of connected cards wins!
- 6) If there is a tie, reshuffle the discard pile and continue playing until this deck has been exhausted as well. Repeat if necessary.







BETSKI CARD BASICS




- There are 49 individual cards in every Betski[™] deck.
- Each deck contains every possible combination of "Gold & Silver" numbers 3 through 9.
- Looking at the top of each card, players will see a GOLD NUMBER (Left) and a SILVER NUMBER (Right).
 - o For improved player visibility, each card has an identical top and bottom set of numbers.

GOLD-TO-SILVER RULE:

This rule will be applicable to all Original Betski[™] games unless stated otherwise in the individual game instructions.

- GOLD NUMBERS (left) are to ONLY be used (played) while being held in the player's hand.
- SILVER NUMBERS (right) are to ONLY be used (played on) once a card has been placed on the table.
- GOLD NUMBERS that are <u>EQUAL TO</u>, <u>OR ONE NUMBER HIGHER THAN</u> the <u>SILVER NUMBERS</u> of cards on the table <u>can</u> be placed next to the viable <u>card(s)</u> on the table.
- Examples of Viable Card placements:
 - If a GOLD number 5 is in the player's hand, they can place the card next to a SILVER 5 OR a SILVER 4 card located on the table.
 - If the player is holding a GOLD number 7, they can place the card next to a SILVER 7 OR a SILVER 6 card located on the table.



- IMPORTANT: This system applies to all other numbers EXCEPT for a GOLD 3, which can be placed next to a SILVER 9 OR a SILVER 3.
 - Players must <u>NEVER</u> place a GOLD 9 on a SILVER 3.
- If a player **cannot** make a move using the Gold-to-Silver Rule, follow the instructions of the game you are playing for the next step(s).
